Author of nearly 200 "in extenso" publications, largely in international journals reviewed by the Journal Citation Reports, and of more than 280 abstracts and presentations at national and international meetings.

From September 2001 to August 2004 he was the local coordinator, as Principal Contractor, of a research group of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia focused on molecular regulation of bile acid synthesis in humans, within an international project funded by the European Union (5th Framework Program), entitled "Studies on the role of orphan nuclear receptors on cholesterol metabolism as new pharmacological targets for cardiovascular diseases and search for ligands modulating their activity".

From October 2006 to March 2010 he coordinated, as Principal Contractor, a research group aimed to study complementary aspects of molecular regulation of bile acid synthesis in humans, within an international project funded by the European Union (6th Framework Program) entitled "Application-oriented studies on regulatory networks involved in lipid homeostasis and atherosclerosis".

From February 2008 to December 2010 he was the Regional Coordinator of a research project funded by the Regione Emilia Romagna within the program of Integrated Projects Regione-Università 2007-2009 - Area di Governo Clinico, entitled "Clinical governance of metabolic diseases: Definition of global cardiovascular risk in patients with type 2 diabetes mellitus. Epidemiological study in a diabetes clinic population".

From December 2009 to November 2012 he has acted as the Local Coordinator for the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia of a research project funded by the Regione Emilia Romagna within the program of Integrated Projects Regione-Università - Area di Governo Clinico, entitled: "Multicenter, open randomized interventional trial to compare DPP-IV inhibitor Vildagliptin with Glybenclamide in order to reach and to maintain a good metabolic control in patients with type 2 DM in therapeutic failure with metformin in monotherapy".

Since 1989/1990 he has been involved, firstly as a lecturer and later as a regular teacher, in formal teaching in the Schools of Specialization in Gastroenterology, Cardiology, Medical Toxicology, Endocrinology and Metabolism, Internal Medicine, Nutrition, of the University of Modena (now University of Modena and Reggio Emilia). Since 1998/1999 he has been teaching in the Undergraduate School for Dietitians in the same University; later on he has been one of the founders of the Graduate School in Dietary Sciences, and a member of the Permanent Board of Teachers of the School ever since.

Since 2000/2001 he has been a permanent teacher in Clinical Methodology in the University of Modena Medical School.

Since 2009/2010 he has been a Teacher of Internal Medicine and Geriatrics in the same Medical School.

Since 2004/2005 until 2006/2007 he has been a regular teacher in the Graduate School in Medical Biotechnology.

He was involved in clinical activity in the medical ward, in outpatients clinics, as a consultant and as a tutor for Medical Students and Residents, in the formerly Unit of Internal Medicine III of the Policlinico Hospital, which since May 6, 2006 has been renamed "Unit of Nutrition and Metabolic Medicine" and has been affiliated to the Local Health District of Modena.

Since December 1, 1994 he has been working in the Lipid Clinic and since September 2001 in the Diabetes Clinic, headed by Prof. Nicola Carulli, within the same Unit, up to December 2010.

From July 1st, 2003 until September 20, 2004 he has been responsible for the Professional Subunit "Prevention of the Metabolic Factors of Cardiovascular Risk" in the same Division. From September 21, 2004 until December 2009 he has been responsible for the Complex Professional Subunit "Prevention of the Metabolic Factors of Cardiovascular Risk" in the same Division.

Since January 2010 he has been appointed as the Chief of the Unit of Geriatric Medicine of the Local Health District of Modena - New City Hospital of Modena.

Over the last few years he has participated in a number of multicentric controlled clinical trials concerning hypolipidemic drugs (cerivastatin, pitavastatin, simvastatin and ezetimibe), hypoglycemic agents (pioglitazone, muraglitazar), drugs used in the management of obesity (rimonabant) and in epidemiological-observational studies as well.
