

Roberto D'Amico

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Professor D'Amico holds a degree in Statistical Sciences from the "La Sapienza" University of Rome and a doctorate in Public Health from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

He carried out methodological research in the field of clinical research at the Mario Negri Pharmacological Research Institute in Milan, where he obtained a specialization in Pharmacological Research.

He was a researcher at the Centre for Statistics in Medicine at the University of Oxford, where he deepened knowledge of methodology of clinical studies and systematic reviews. He worked as statistician at the CEVEAS, Centre for the Evaluation of the Effectiveness of Health Services, of the AUSL of Modena. He was the director of Cochrane Italy for more than a decade.

At the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, he teaches Medical Statistics in several health-related degree courses and in medical residencies. He is the director of the postgraduate course in Statistics Applied to Clinical Questions and that in Systematic Reviews and Cochrane Meta-Analysis. He is also a member of the faculty of the doctorate in Clinical and Experimental Medicine.

He is the director of the Unit of Methodological and Statistical Support for Clinical Research at the University Hospital of Modena. He has participated as a principal investigator in several clinical research projects.

His research focuses on statistical methodology applied to primary and secondary clinical research, particularly studies that address clinical questions of efficacy, prognosis, and diagnostic accuracy.
