The project aims to analyze how contemporary educational systems contribute to the symbolic and normative construction of citizenship, examining the tensions between inclusion, conflict, and subject formation. The research group, based at the Università di Modena e Reggio Emilia (DESU and DSLC), will develop a theoretical and critical inquiry that brings together critical pedagogy, political philosophy, and the history of education, with particular attention to the utopian and dystopian imaginaries that traverse educational and civic practices. The project focuses on issues such as symbolic recognition, tokenism, black pedagogy, and forms of democratic citizenship, relating them to liberal-socialist traditions and to the legacies of twentieth-century pedagogy. A further line of investigation addresses postwar cinema and visual culture, approached as sites for the symbolic validation of representations of citizenship and social conflict. Planned activities include an initial phase of theoretical elaboration and the construction of the research corpus, seminars and public discussions, and the subsequent production of scholarly outputs aimed at providing a coherent and contemporary account of the nexus between education, the democratic imaginary, and critical pedagogy.
