

Dr. Albino Eccher trained at the University of Verona, where he obtained his Medical Doctor (MD) degree in 2002 and the Diploma of Pathologists in 2007. He began his career at the Integrated University Hospital of Verona in 2007, and received a PhD in Human Oncology in 2010. Since 2007, he has held executive positions at the Integrated University Hospital of Verona with a functional professional role in the diagnostics of transplant (IPF, 2013– 2020) and as a simple unit in cytology (US, 2020–2023), and has covered the diagnostic session for extemporaneous exams for surgical room activities as Associate Professor from the Ministry of Health, and in 2019, he was appointed by the Ministry of Health as oncological second opinion for the National Interest include innovation in the diagnostic process in anatomic pathology, and in this setting, embracing and implementing the role of digital pathology in order to switch from conventional light microscopy to computational pathology. During his career, he has engaged in numerous international collaborations with well-recognized opinion leaders in digital pathology, which have resulted in many projects, publications, and collaborations. Indeed, as leader of an international group on digital pathology, his group performed primary studies and world-class systematic pathology and digital pathology reviews.

Since 31/7/2023 he is Full Professor at Unimore.
