Gianluigi Fioriglio is Associate Professor of “Informatica giuridica” (Legal Informatics) (from a.y. 2026/2027 “Informatica giuridica e diritto della privacy” – Legal Informatics and Privacy Law) and “Sociologia del diritto ed elementi di Informatica giuridica” (Sociology of Law and Elements of Legal Informatics) at the Department of Law (Dipartimento di Giurisprudenza) of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia (from a.y. 2026/2027 also of “Diritto e intelligenza artificiale” – Law and Artificial Intelligence), as well as of “Filosofia del diritto” (Philosophy of Law) and “Sociologia giuridica” (Sociology of Law) at the Military Academy of Modena.
