Dr. Galeazzi was born in Piacenza, Italy, in 1970.

EDUCATION

He graduated in Medicine and Surgery with full honors in 1994 at the University of Parma, Italy; He completed his specialist training in Psychiatry with full honors in 1998 at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, where he also completed a PhD in Human Psychobiology in 2004.

CURRENT APPOINTMENT

Since 1st of December 2019 Full Professor of Psychiatry, Section of Clinical Neurosciences, Dept. of Biomedical, Metabolic and Neural Sciences, University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, Via del Pozzo 71, 41124- Modena, Italy. He also holds a post as Director of the Department of Mental Health and Drug Abuse of the local area Mental Health Service (Azienda USL-IRCCS di Reggio Emilia) delivering comprehensive mental health services to a population of approximately 500.000.

His **teaching** tasks include teaching Psychiatry to undergraduates in Medicine and at the university degree to become a Psychiatric Rehabilitation Therapist, of which he was the President since January 2016 till November 2021. He also teaches Psychiatry at the degree courses to become Dietician and Health Assistant. He is Director of the School of Specialization of Psychiatry of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia since November 2017.

From the **clinical** point of view, he has experience in working in diverse clinical settings (acute inpatient, outpatient, rehabilitation, consultation/liaison), within different cultures and healthcare systems (UK, Italy, Germany, Australia), which has helped him to develop the ability to quickly adapt to new programs/organizations.

From the **research** point of view, his main interests and expertise areas cover:

- stalking;
- posttraumatic stress disorder in particular with populations refugees and displaced persons;
- social psychiatry (with published research on topics such as psychiatric epidemiology, social determinants of mental health, coercion, interpersonal violence, team morale, therapeutic relationship issues in community mental health care)
- consultation liaison psychiatry
- recovery and psychiatric rehabilitation
- lgbtqa+ mental health

On these topics he has published more than 130 papers in peer reviewed journals, his contemporary Google Scholar Indexes are 5219 citations, 37 of h-index and 87 of i10-index.
