

Prof. FEDERICO PEDRINI
CURRICULUM VITAE

Federico Pedrini is full professor of Constitutional Law at the Department of Law of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia. A former student of the “Collegio Superiore” of the University of Bologna, he graduated in Law in 2004 (best of his year) with Augusto Barbera discussing a thesis on fundamental rights and constitutional justice. Winner of a scholarship for a PhD in Comparative and European Legal Studies at the University of Trento, he renounced it being first in the competition for a PhD in Constitutional Law at the University of Bologna, where in 2008 he graduated with honors discussing a thesis on “constitutional law of consumption” under the guidance of Augusto Barbera and Aljs Vignudelli. Since 2008, after having obtained the qualification to practice law at the Court of Appeal of Brescia, he is a researcher (then senior researcher) in Constitutional Law at the University of Bologna, where he collaborates with the chairs of professors Barbera, Morrone and Giupponi. Several times DAAD (Deutscher Akademischer Austauschdienst) scholarship holder, from 2012 to 2014 he is Research Fellow of the Alexander von Humboldt-Stiftung at the Faculty of Law of the Freie Universität Berlin, where he leads a research on general constitutional clauses under the direction of Philip Kunig. Author of numerous essays and three monographs, he has spoken at numerous national and international seminars and study meetings, and has held courses in Public Law Institutions, Theory of Constitutional Interpretation, Regional Law and Information and Communication Law, as well as in Constitutional Law. He is a member of the Italian Association of Constitutionalists, a member of the Board of Lecturers of the Doctorate in Legal Sciences (in consortium between the University of Parma and the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia), he has been a member of the Research Commission of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, President of the Research Commission, and of the Teaching Commission of the Department of Law.
