### **Short Curriculum Vitae (updated as of June 20, 2025)**

Dr. Luca Pingani holds a degree in Psychiatric Rehabilitation Techniques from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia and a Master's Degree in Health Professions of Rehabilitation Sciences from the University of Florence. He was awarded a two-year research and advanced training scholarship by the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia. He also completed a Postgraduate Course in Statistics Applied to Clinical Questions (University of Modena and Reggio Emilia) and a Postgraduate Course in Systematic Reviews, Meta-Analyses, and Clinical Guidelines in Healthcare (University of Verona). He earned a Ph.D. in Clinical and Experimental Medicine from the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

He holds national qualification as Full Professor in the disciplinary field 06/N1 Health Professions and Applied Medical Technologies.

From the academic year 2006/2007 to 2022/2023, he served as Director of Educational Activities for the Degree Course in Psychiatric Rehabilitation Techniques at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia. He currently teaches in the Degree Programs in Psychiatric Rehabilitation Techniques, Health Assistance, and the Single-Cycle Master's Degree in Medicine and Surgery at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia. He is also a lecturer in Research Methodology at the School of Specialization in Psychiatry at the same university.

He carries out clinical-institutional integration as a Healthcare Professional Manager at the Azienda USL – IRCCS of Reggio Emilia, within the Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services.

Dr. Pingani is listed in the National Register of Experts of ANVUR (Italian National Agency for the Evaluation of Universities and Research Institutes) for initial and periodic evaluation of academic programs and institutions. He is a member of the Academic Board of the PhD Program in Neurosciences at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, and serves as a COST-Action External Expert for the European Commission.
