

I am full professor of Psychology at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia (2005-) and I am director of the PhD program in Neuroscience in the same University (2022-). I received the master degree in Psychology at the University of Padova and doctoral training at the University of Bologna. I had a previous faculty position at the University of Urbino (1997-2000). Research in my laboratory (Neuroscience and Psychology Lab) is mainly focused on the study of the neurocognitive mechanisms and psychological functions underlying human attention and control, the links between perception and action, and the social behavior. Using both behavioral and cognitive neuroscience methods my empirical research is focused on a variety of subject populations (healthy adults, brain damaged patients, typically and atypically developing children). I authored or co-authored more than 70 peer-reviewed publications in cognitive psychology and neuroscience journals.
