#### Teaching Activities

Since the academic year 2003/2004, he has taught, as course leader or co-lecturer, a wide range of courses in the field of public law, including Public Law, Public Economic Law, Regional and Local Government Law, Administrative Law and Territorial Autonomies, European Union Law, Legal Foundations of Employment Relations, Digital Economy Law, Legislative Drafting and Evaluation at the Marco Biagi Department of Economics, as well as Financial Law at the Department of Law of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

Since the academic year 2023/2024, he has been teaching School Legislation at the Multidisciplinary Centre for Teacher Education of the same university.

In the academic years 2021/2022, 2022/2023 and 2024/2025, he was also course leader for Information Technology Law and New Technologies Law at the Department of Physical, Computer and Mathematical Sciences of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

In the academic year 2008/2009, he taught Constitutional Law and Constitutional Law II at the Faculty of Law of the University of Genoa (Imperia campus).

At the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, he has also lectured in first- and second-level Master's programmes, including Health, Safety and Environment Expert in Public and Private Workplaces – *HSE Management*; Organizational Models, Training and Occupational Risk Assessment – *Safety Management*; Labour Market Operator; Employability and Placement.

From 2018/2019 to 2023/2024, he taught in the Second-Level Master's Programme in Data Protection Officer and Privacy Expert at Roma Tre University. Since 2024/2025, he has continued his teaching activities at the same university within the Second-Level Master's Programme in Personal Data Protection, Cybersecurity and New Technologies Law: Data Protection Officer, Chief Information Security Officer and Chief Artificial Intelligence Officer.

He has also taught courses on data protection law within several advanced university programmes, including *Privacy and Data Security Management* (which he directed) and *Management of Complex Healthcare Organizations*.

He is a member of the Faculty Board of the Ph.D. Programme in Labour, Development and Innovation (E4E Doctoral School – *Engineering for Economics, Economics for Engineering*), where he teaches and coordinates

the course Labour and New Technologies: Legal Issues and the research track Personal Data Protection, Artificial Intelligence and Digital Market Regulation.

He has taught in the advanced training programme promoted by the Emilia-Romagna Region, The City School: Experimenting with the Human-Centred City 4.0, held at the Modena Datacenter, and in the Winter School Personal Data Protection and Information Security in Employment Relations, organized by the Marco Biagi Foundation.

He has also delivered professional training courses for accredited private training providers on personal data protection law (Proleven S.r.l.) and on data protection and algorithmic administrative decision-making (Centro Studio e Lavoro “La Cremeria” S.r.l.).

### Research Activities

He is the author of more than 120 publications covering several areas of Constitutional Law, with particular focus on Sources of Law and Legislative Drafting, Fundamental Rights, Regional Law, Constitutional Justice, Public Economic Law, Law and New Technologies.
