PROF. SIMONE SCAGLIARINI

Simone Scagliarini is Full Professor of Public Law at the “Marco Biagi” Department of Economics of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, where, since the academic year 2003/04, he has held several courses in the field of Public Law, including Public Economic Law, European Union Law, Computer Science and New Technologies Law and Economic Digital Law. He has also taught, especially regarding the topic of personal data protection and legal drafting, in various Master's courses, at the Modena and Reggio Emilia University and at the Roma 3 University.

He is the author of more than 110 scientific publications on issues related to Constitutional and Public Law, with a specific focus on personal data protection and the impact of new technologies on rights, public economic law, sources of law and legal drafting.

He has been speaker in several conferences and seminars in Italy and abroad, mainly on the subjects of personal data protection and legal drafting. He has participated in several research projects; in this sense, *inter alia*, he is Principal Investigator in the project “*Regulatory tools for the prevention and fight against gambling in the digital age*” (PRIN: research project of national interest).

He coordinates the *Observatory on Privacy, Artificial Intelligence and New Technologies* of the Marco Biagi Foundation, the Working Group *Law and Ethics for Autonomous Driving* within the Modena Automotive Smart Area (MASA) project and he is member of the Scientific Committee of the *SMART CITY 4.0 Sustainable LAB Research Laboratory*, based at the University of Parma.

He is member of the Faculty of the PhD in *Labour, Development and Innovation*, in which he leads the research line “*Data Protection, Artificial Intelligence, Regulation of Digital Markets*” and the course “*Work and AI: legal profiles*”.
