

## **Simone Tepedino CV**

Simone Tepedino is adjunct professor of the courses OFA Spanish Language (Department on Studies of Language and Culture) and Spanish Language I and II (Department of Economics “Marco Biagi”). He obtained a PhD in Human Sciences (more specifically, in Spanish Language and Translation) at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia in 2019.

His research interests focus mainly on discourse analysis, especially in relation to nation building processes in Spain. Within this focus, a particular attention goes to the Restoration period and its connection with bullfighting history and culture.

He is also professor of English language and culture at Lazzaro Spallanzani Institute in Castelfranco Emilia.

He was adjunct professor in Mantua University Foundation between 2019 and 2021, holding the courses of Spanish Literature and Culture and Spanish Language III.

### **Education and training**

He graduated in 2009 at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia in Languages for Communication in International Enterprises and Organizations. Mark: 110 *cum laude*. The thesis examined the historical and cultural aspects of the *corrida de toros* in Contemporary Spain. In the same university he obtained a PhD in Human Sciences discussing a thesis entitled *Tauromaquia y nacionalismo: un análisis del discurso*. In this work, he underlined the linguistic and cultural similarities between the conservative nationalistic discourse and the values promoted by bullfighting press at the turn of the XIX and XX century.

### **Research activities**

- Collaborator with the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia in the project “FAR Dipartimento 2020”, Department on Studies of Language and Culture.
- From November 2016 to April 2017, he spent a first Fulbright research period in Madrid, at the Complutense University (Facultad de Ciencias Políticas y Sociología), followed by a second period – from September to December 2017 – in the same institution. Both allowed to do research in the main libraries specialised in bullfighting, and also to work in strict contact with José Álvarez Junco.
- Member of AISPI since November 2019.
- Collaborator with the magazine “Spagna Contemponea”, for which he also carried out editing activity.
