### **SHORT CURRICULUM VITAE**

Born in Modena (Italy) on July 17th, 1955.

Graduated in Medicine at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, with 110/110 cum laude, in 1979.

Professional qualification since 1979.

Specialist in Radiology with 70/70 cum laude, in 1983.

Specialist in Oncologist with 70/70 cum laude, in 1988.

### **CLINICAL ACTIVITY**

He has practiced as a Medical Doctor from 1986 to 2000 at the Radiology Department of Azienda Ospedaliera Policlinico of Modena.

Since November 1st, 2000, he practices (till to 2016 as Associate Professor and later as Full Professor in Radiology) at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, and he acts his clinical radiological activity at the Radiology Department of the Azienda Ospedaliero-Universitaria Policlinico of Modena.

Since May 1st, 2005, he is Chief of the Section of Radiology of the Integrated Radiology Department of the Policlinico Hospital of Modena.

Since May 28th, 2010, he is Director of the Diagnostic Imaging Department of the Azienda Ospedaliero-Universitaria Policlinico of Modena.

### **SCIENTIFIC ACTIVITY**

His main topics of interest are Computed Tomography and Magnetic Resonance applications in the oncologic and orthopaedic field, regarding in particular the diagnosis and follow-up of muscle-skeletal, urogenital and gastrointestinal neoplasm.

He participated from 1991 to 1997 at the C.N.R. project dealing with clinical applications of Oncology Research, taking over research on Magnetic Resonance applications in evaluating preoperative intra-arterial chemotherapy effect in osteosarcoma management.

He participates to many research groups in the oncology and radiotherapy field, active at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

He had been Secretary of the Computed Tomography section of the Italian Radiology Society (SIRM) from 1992 to 1996 and of Member of the decisional council of the same section from 1996 to 2000.

He is Author or co-Author of more than 300 scientific publications on national and international journals, and of many chapters in radiology books. His most recent scientific production regards Magnetic Resonance imaging in the oncology field.

He participated, as a teaching professor, Speaker or co-Author, to more than 200 scientific events in Italy and abroad. In particular, he had been part of the Italian Society of Medical Radiology (SIRM) teaching groups regarding Urogenital Oncology, Computed Tomography in Emergency and Magnetic Resonance.

He has been part of the reviewer board of the following journals: " La Radiologia Medica", "European Radiology", "Surgical Oncology", "BMC Cancer".

### **TEACHING ACTIVITY**

Since 1988-89 he has been teaching in many Specialization Schools of the Medical School of the University of Modena and Reggio-Emilia.

Nowadays, he is Full Professor of Radiology at the courses of Medicine/Surgery and Radiographers of the School of Medicine and Surgery of Modena and Reggio Emilia University.

From 2003 to 2018, he has been the Chief Director of the Specialization School in Diagnostic Radiology of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

From 2018 to 2020, he has been President of the School for Radiographers of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

From 2019 to 2021, he has been vice-Director of the Department of Medical Surgical Pediatric Gynecologic and Adult Sciences of the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

From 2019 until now he is member of the Board of Directors of the University of Modena and Reggio-Emilia.
