

Professor Alessandro Turchi graduated in Law in 1992 at the University of Modena, where he began collaborating in 1995.

He obtained the title of PhD in Tax Law at the University of Pisa in 2000. In 2004 he became eligible for associate professorship of Tax Law. The following year he served as Associate Professor of Tax Law at the Faculty of Law at the University of Modena and Reggio Emilia.

In 2013 e in 2019 he gained national scientific qualification as a full professor in Tax Law.

In the academic year 2025/2026 he teaches at the "Marco Biagi" Economics Department courses of Tax Law (CLEAM, 3rd year) and Advanced Tax Law (DCI, 1st year) and, at the Department of Law, a course of Tax Law (SGIPA, 3rd year).

He has written six monographs on tax law topics and over one hundred publications in specialized books and reviews.

He oversaw the updating of the manuals of prof. Francesco Tesoro: *Istituzioni di diritto tributario*, *Compendio di diritto tributario* and *Manuale del processo tributario*.

He has given numerous lectures and reports at conferences, advanced courses and master's degrees.
